Fire Risk Assessments Conducted



The Fire Precautions (Workplace) Regulations 1997 (Amended 1999) and the New Fire Legislation effective now from 1st October 2006 places a legal obligation on employers to conduct Fire Risk Assessment and ensure adequate training of personnel with regards to fire safety. Insurers are also increasingly requiring their customers to demonstrate that they are taking a responsible approach to fire safety, particularly the safety of staff, customers, visitors and property.

NewGrange Training & Services Ltd. can provide Fire Safety Audits and Fire Risk Assessments designed to meet the customer's needs. Fire Risk Assessments are undertaken in compliance with the requirements of the Fire Precautions (Workplace) Regulations 1997 (as amended 1999).

What is a Fire Safety Risk Assessment?

A fire safety audit is an analysis of the fire risks. An audit, including a review of the fire risk assessment, should be carried out every year or:

- when there are extensions or alterations made
- when there are changes in the number of employees
- when there is a change of use at the premises
- when there is the installation of new equipment or systems

A fire safety audit would also check for compliance with the Fire Certificate, contravention of which is a criminal offence.
