



Practical Fire Safety Awareness

Radical changes to Fire Safety Laws with the new Fire Safety Order effective from 1st October '06 will have implications for all UK businesses. **This is the biggest single reform of fire safety legislation in nearly 35 years** which will simplify the law for thousands of businesses while placing a greater focus on prevention.

The new law consolidates existing fire legislation, and repeals the Fire Precautions Act 1971. At present fire safety laws are scattered across more than 120 pieces of legislation. **The Regulatory Reform Fire Safety Order improves fire safety by placing the responsibility for fire safety on the employer or 'responsible person' for that building or premises. He or she will be required to assess the risks of fire and take steps to reduce or remove them.**
