



## Fire Marshal/Warden

**Who should attend?** Anyone with responsibility for assisting with emergency evacuation arrangements in their workplace, including fire co-ordinators, fire wardens/marshals, supervisors/managers with fire safety responsibilities or health and safety representatives from any type of organisation.
