The course is based entirely on the Associations "Code of Practice for the use of High Pressure Water Jetting Equipment". It is a practical course containing hands on training with the equipment together with some lecture room subjects. The course is designed to give the trainee knowledge of a safe way in which to use the equipment.

The Objectives of the Course

At the end of the course trainees should:

- Have a detailed knowledge of all the hazards associated with water jetting.
- Understand the items of water jetting equipment as used for drain and sewer cleaning.
- Understand the different control systems that are in use including pressure safety relief devices.
- Have a clear understanding of the special needs for maintenance inspection and testing of high pressure equipment on a regular basis.
- Understand the potential hazards of incorrect connection of high pressure hoses, guns and lances.
- Have a detailed knowledge of the nature of water jetting injuries and the correct action to take in the event of an accident.
- Understand the requirement, for personal protective clothing and equipment and it's limitations.
- Understand the safety procedures necessary when water jetting operations take place on or near a public highway, footpath or area where other persons may be nearby.
- Have knowledge of the Associations "Code of Practice, for the use of High Pressure Water Jetting Equipment".
- Be able to set up and barricade off water jetting site in order to prevent other people from exposing themselves to the hazards of water jetting.
- Carry out the preliminary checks on the equipment, start and stop it safely.
- Be able to operate the equipment without endangering himself or others.

Who Should Attend

The course is aimed at:

- New or inexperienced operators of water jetting equipment
- Experienced operators who have not had previous training and who needs to improve their knowledge and skills.
- Experienced operators who require re-training due to changes in equipment specification or legislation.
