- Appreciation of DEFRA and EA Guidance on plan form and content for banded project values
- Techniques for forecasting amounts of key waste streams and predicting reuse, recycling and disposal
- Defining responsibilities of key parties in a typical project
- Examples of reduction, reuse or recycling for key waste streams
- Recording and retaining information in support of the SWMP
